Gunma University • Summer Program 2018

Application Requirements

1. Objectives:

The distinctive features of this program offered to undergraduate and graduate students from the Gunma University Partner Universities include an intensive program in the Japanese language and culture. This program has been created by Gunma University to introduce Gunma University to partner universities and to promote a deeper understanding and appreciation of Japanese society and culture.

2. Requirements and conditions for participation:

- 1) Students who are currently and who will be enrolled in a Partner University of Gunma University until the final day of the program.
- 2) A student's Japanese ability must be at the upper beginner level (Japanese language learning time 150 200 hours, Japanese Language Proficiency Test N5 passing level.
- 3) Students must be able to understand a lecture conducted in English.
- 4) Students must take part in the entire program.
- 5) Students must purchase an overseas travel insurance plan prior to their arrival in Japan.

3. General information:

- **Period:** Monday, July 9~ Friday, July 20, 2018 (12days)
- Number of participants: 15 students
- **Participation fee:** ¥70,000 JPY (This fee includes cost of lodging during the program period, expenses for excursions, and costs related to class tuition)
- **Personal expenses:** All travel expenses to and from Gunma University, breakfast, lunch and dinner expenses, costs for any personal tourist and sightseeing activities, and overseas travel insurance.
- **4. Program overview:** This program is an opportunity to learn about and experience traditional Japanese culture by taking part in lectures related to Japanese culture (conducted in English), activities introducing Japanese language, calligraphy, tea ceremony, Japanese music, archery, and a homestay with a Japanese family. There will also be opportunities to interact with Japanese students. A Certificate of Completion will be issued to those who complete the entire program.

5. Lodging:

Students will have access to accommodation facilities located approximately 5 minutes walking distance from the Gunma University campus. Bedrooms are private, single occupancy rooms that are situated within a common unit shared by three students. Students will have access to a washing machine and a dryer. Wi-Fi is also available in the facility. If desired, breakfast can be purchased for 4400 yen. Please inform the facility that you would like to have breakfast one day before. Please note that the breakfast menu will not include halal food.

If you need a certificate for a visa application, we will send it to you by the end of May 2018.

After receiving a notice of acceptance, participants should prepare -

- 1) A copy of the applicant's valid passport
- 2) A copy of a purchased airplane ticket

8. About Gunma University:

Gunma University is located 100 km northwest of Tokyo and consists of four faculties: Faculty of Education, Faculty of Social and Information Studies, Faculty of Medicine, Faculty of Science and Technology. Currently, about 6,500 students are enrolled, of which approximately 250 are international students. In the academic year 2017, about 30 students from our partner universities have so far studied for half a year or one year.
