To All Students

Gunma University will be conducting a mass vaccination of students and faculty members against the new coronavirus as a first step to help students lead a safe and fulfilling university life.

If you have not received a vaccination ticket, please contact the prefectural government. Those who have not received the vaccination coupon, those who live outside the prefecture, and international students are also eligible.

We will start accepting applications from June 30 (Wed.), so please make an appointment through the Gunma University Information System.

Please make an appointment through the Educational Affairs System. If you have a preexisting medical condition that makes you uncomfortable about getting vaccinated, please consult with your family doctor.

If you have any concerns about the vaccination due to a chronic illness, please consult with your family doctor and consider whether you would like to receive the vaccination.

Students of the School of Medicine (including graduate school) are not eligible for this vaccination as they have already been notified by the Showa District Academic Affairs Division as priority recipients of the Gunma Prefecture vaccination.

This vaccination is based on request and is not mandatory. Those who do not receive the vaccine will not be disadvantaged.

1. Vaccination schedule, etc.

Please note that the schedule (category) for which you can make an appointment differs depending on the faculty (graduate school, etc.) and academic year.

2. Vaccination time: 9:30 a.m. to the end of the day's scheduled vaccinations (approximately 4:30 p.m.)

- 4. How to make an appointment: Please log in to the Educational Records and Programs system and make an appointment through "MEDICAL EXAMINATION".
- 5. Appointment period: 6 days from June 30 (Wed.) to July 5 (Mon.)

The second vaccination will be given at the same time 4 weeks after the first one. Be sure to confirm the date and time of the second vaccination. Note that the health checkup appointment confirmation does not show the second appointment date.

(Example) If you make a reservation for the first session on Saturday, July 17, 9:30-10:00, the second session will be held on Saturday, August 14, 9:30-10:00.

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**Please note that you cannot change your reservation after the reservation period has expired.

**Please note that you can change your appointment during the appointment period.

Students who have enrolled this year or who have not answered the "Mental Health Questionnaire" this year should make an appointment after answering the "Mental Health Questionnaire".

- 6. 《Important》 Note to students who have made an appointment for vaccination at Gunma University.
- OStudents who have made an appointment for vaccination at Gunma University can receive other vaccinations such as "vaccinations at municipalities" and "general vaccinations at the Prefectural Central Vaccination Center". Students who have made reservations for vaccinations administered by Gunma University should not make reservations for other "municipal vaccinations" or "general vaccinations at the Kenoh Vaccination Center.
