




Gunma University 2026 5-Day Summer Session

Dive into Japan, Explore Gunma University!

July 6–10, 2026 (Monday–Friday)

Gunma Prefecture is home to Shibukawa City, often regarded as Japan's geographical center. Just south of Shibukawa lies Maebashi City, where Gunma University's Aramaki and Showa Campuses are located. To the northeast of Maebashi, you'll find Kiryu City with the Kiryu Campus, and to the southeast lies Ota City, home to the Ota Campus. This program is designed for students from our partner universities to explore Japan and Gunma University through lectures, student exchange activities, and field trips throughout Gunma. Participants will spend several days experiencing campus life at Gunma University, engaging with local students and faculty, and gaining first-hand insight into what makes our university unique.
